Topic: Combining clinical work and establishing a clinical trial portfolio

Dr Adam Januszewski is a Consultant Thoracic Oncologist at St Bartholomew's Hospital, Barts Health NHS Trust, and a member of the Barts Cancer Centre. His clinical practice spans the full lung cancer pathway, with particular interests in early-stage disease, complex decision-making, and improving the patient experience during treatment.

Dr Januszewski has extensive involvement in clinical trials and research delivery. He works closely with multidisciplinary and research teams to integrate trials into routine care, improve recruitment pathways, and ensure safe, practical implementation within busy oncology services. He is co-manager of the research delivery team, UK chief investigator on numerous commercial trials and working actively on improving recruitment in particular those individuals from diverse and deprived backgrounds. His academic interests include molecular diagnostics, ctDNA-guided care, and the incorporation of targeted therapies and immunotherapy into contemporary lung cancer pathways.
