**Dr Daniel J. Hughes** Consultant Medical Oncologist, Guy's Cancer Centre & ACP Executive Committee Member

Dr Daniel J. Hughes is a Consultant Medical Oncologist in Thoracic Cancers and Acute Oncology at Guy's Cancer Centre, London since 2025.

Daniel completed his training in medical oncology at University College London Hospital, having been awarded an NIHR Academic Clinical Fellowship. He has worked at multiple centres throughout his training, including the Royal Marsden, Royal Free Hospital and Guy's Cancer Centre.

He completed his PhD in Molecular Imaging of PD-L1 at King's College London in 2024. He has broad research interests, including real-world evidence in thoracic cancers, as well as novel therapeutic drugs and combination therapeutic approaches.

Having completed the NIHR Associate PI scheme during training, Daniel is currently developing a trials portfolio; he is the co-CI of the national REALorla study, and has several studies in set-up as PI. He has published in high-impact, peer-reviewed journals and presented in international meetings in the fields of molecular imaging in cancer, real-world outcomes in cancer, and medical oncology.

Having completed an MSc in Medical Education in 2019 (UCL, London), he also has a passion for medical education and training and has recently taken on a leadership role at Guy's supporting the resident ward doctors.

Daniel has been an active member of the ACP Executive Committee for several years, currently holding the role of Communications and Strategy Lead. He is the lead organiser of the ACP Conference 2026 and co-Chair of the '*Clinical Trials Masterclass*'. He is looking forward to welcoming you all to Birmingham in April!
