Dr Hockings is a Consultant Medical Oncologist at Guy's and St Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust, London, specialising in gynaecological cancers.

She completed a Cancer Research UK-funded PhD at Barts Cancer Institute, where her research explored adaptive therapy as a strategy to delay the development of platinum resistance in ovarian cancer.

Her work has been recognised with several awards, including the Association of Cancer Physicians' President's Prize and an AACR Scholar-in-Training Award. She developed the ACTOv study through the Experimental Cancer Medicine Centres Junior Investigator Network Group and served as an NIHR Associate Principal Investigator during specialist training. She is now a Principal Investigator on the trial.

In addition to her research and clinical work, she has a strong interest in medical education, holding a Postgraduate Certificate in Medical Education and serving as an Educational Fellow and faculty member on the ICR Diploma in Oncology course.
