She was awarded the Cancer Research UK Gordon Hamilton Fairly Clinical Fellowship to complete her PhD in the molecular subtyping of Breast Cancer at the Barts Cancer Institute.

Rebecca is the Deputy Chair of GTG-UK (formerly NCRI Gynae) research group and is UK chief investigator and local principal investigator on numerous oncology clinical trials. She is co-chair for UKGOM and a member of UKBCG.
