Rosie Tansley is a final-year ESRC-funded PhD candidate whose research focuses on intense interests and learning support for secondary school-aged young people in the UK. Her work is grounded in participatory methods and centres the lived experiences of marginalised groups within her work.

She co-teaches on the third-year undergraduate Rethinking Autism module at the University of Southampton and advocates for social justice and inclusive practice across education and healthcare. Rosie is also a community researcher on the Whatever It Takes: Cancer Care for Everyone project, collaborating with Help & Care, Macmillan, the NHS and community groups to improve cancer services for disabled and neurodivergent people.
